Overview

This qualification is aimed at individuals engaged in a teaching assistant or similar educational role who provide support to learners in an educational environment.

It is a progression route for those who already hold a Level 3 Certificate or Diploma in Supporting Teaching and Learning, or the equivalent, and who are engaged in Continuing Professional Development to enhance their career prospects by developing their knowledge, understanding and practice of providing teaching and learning support.

To achieve the qualification the following mandatory units will be covered:

- Class management and managing behaviour
- Understanding child development and how children learn
- Working in partnership

- Understanding lesson plans and schemes of work
- Reflecting, reviewing and evaluating own practice

These will be enhanced by one of the following optional units:

- Learning mentor role
- Family support worker role
- Special Educational Needs and Disabilities
- Developing and delivering own lesson plans
- Speech, language and communication
- Use of technology
- Social, emotional and mental health in children and young people

You will work with an assessor to complete a portfolio of evidence that confirms you have met the requirements of the qualification.

Entry requirement – to undertake this qualification you should be able to demonstrate that you have achieved a level of knowledge, understanding and practice through the attainment of a Level 3 Certificate or Diploma in Supporting Teaching and Learning, or the equivalent.
